

# Nancy Pelosi will become Speaker again with numbers slightly worse than when Newt Gingrich left Congress.



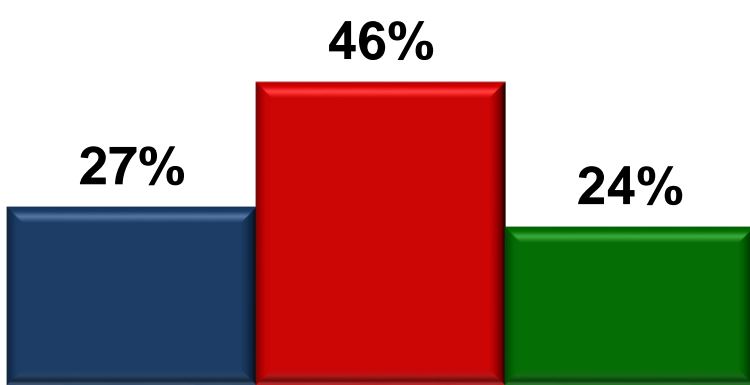

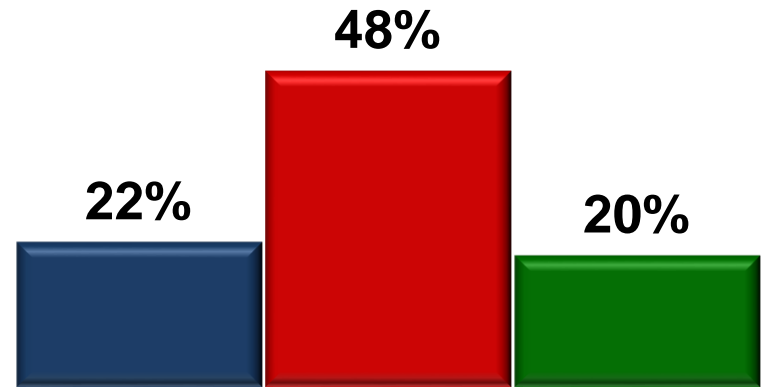

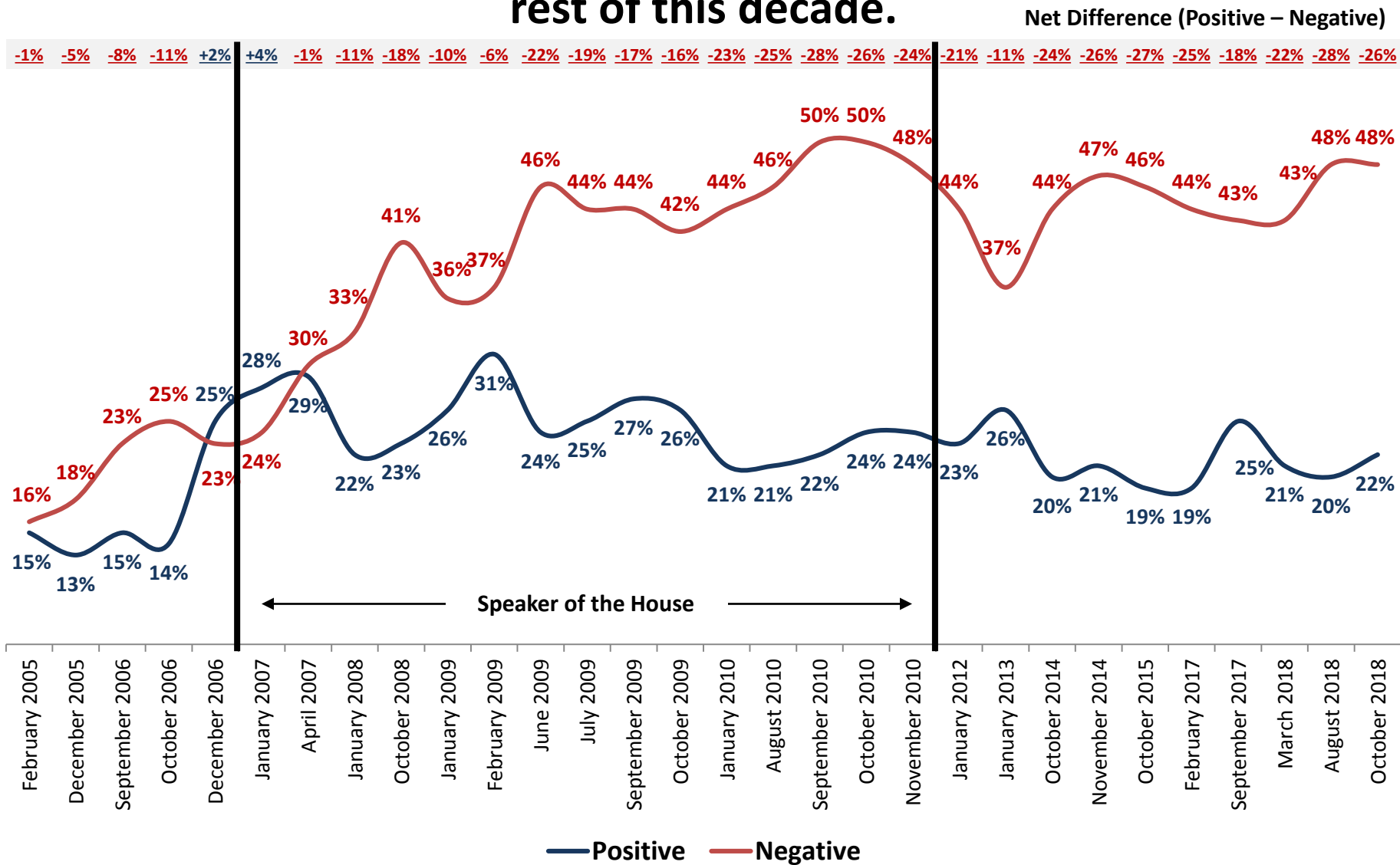

# Nancy Pelosi quickly had high negative ratings during her previous tenure as Speaker, which have stayed in place for the rest of this decade.



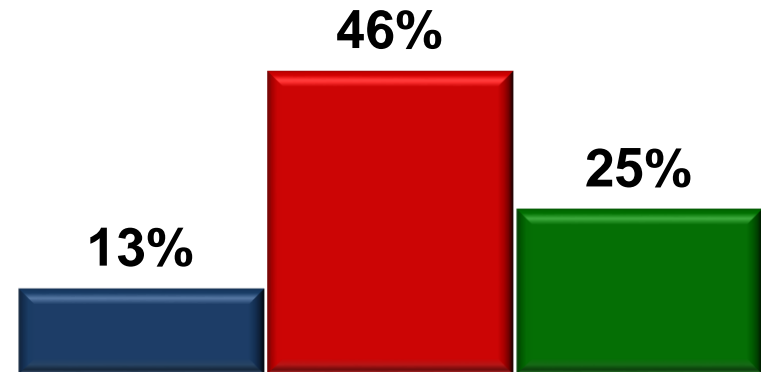
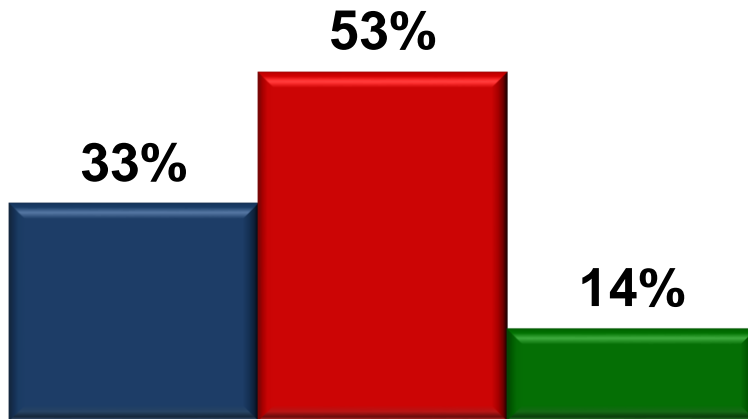
# Pelosi's net negative rating among Independents is higher than Donald Trump's!


